Subject: Takata Airbag Exclusion

I request that USEPA waive the 30-day hold before filing adopted amendments and allow the Board to file prospective amendments immediately after the Board adopts them. This will allow an earlier effective date in Illinois for the Takata airbag exclusion.

The Board will propose the Takata airbag exclusion on Thursday. After publication in the *Illinois Register* and 45-day public comment period, it is possible that the Board will vote to adopt the amendments as early as the end of April.

If the Board immediately files the amendments after adopting them, we could see an effective date before May 1, 2019.

If the Board follows the usual course and delays filing for 30 days to allow USEPA rule before filing, we will have an effective date after June 1, 2019.

We sense urgency on USEPA's part in effecting this rule. If USEPA waives the 30-day delay in filing and focuses review on the proposed rule, we can save about five weeks in the effective date.
