<u>AC 22-1</u>	<u>Illinois Environmental Protection Agency v. Mark Siefert</u> (Public Water Supply) – After Siefert failed to timely file a petition to contest the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency’s administrative citation, the Board found that Siefert violated Section 1.1(b)(3) of the Public Water Supply Operations Act (415 ILCS 45/1.1(b)(3) (2020)), as alleged. Because there were two violations of Section 1.1(b)(3), the Board ordered the Siefert to pay a total civil penalty of \$1,000, reflecting the statutory penalty of \$500 per violation	4-0 roll call vote


