This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1, formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, Ch. 111 ½, par. 1031.1, and delegated to the County of LaSalle pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 111 ½, par. 1004 (r).

#### **FACTS**

- 1. That Respondent, Derek Moore is the present owner of property located in Richland Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump/open burn site, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and is designated with Site Code No. 0998285005 Said facility is commonly known to the Agency as Moore Property.
- 3. That the Respondent has owned said facility since June 22nd, 2018.
- 4. That on April 25th, 2024, Lauren Grumieaux and Myranda Lakan of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

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5. On the basis of direct observations of Lauren Grumieaux and Myranda Lakan of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping and open burning at the above-described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

That on April 25, 2024, an on-site inspection of said facility disclosed the following:

#### CIVIL PENALTY

- 6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred(\$4500.00). Additionally, should Respondents elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
- 7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.
- 8. When payment is made, one certified check or money order for (\$2,250) shall be made payable to the **LaSalle County Treasurer** and mailed to:

9. If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after the adjudicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

#### NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

#### GENERAL REMARKS

On April 25, 2024, an open dumping and open burning inspection was conducted at 950 N 14<sup>th</sup> Rd., by Ms. Myranda Lakan and Ms. Lauren Grumieaux representing the LaSalle County Land Use Department, under the delegation authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The inspection was a result of a complaint referred from the IEPA Rockford office regarding open burning of construction debris from a demolition project in Streator.

Weather conditions on April 25, 2024, were sunny and 55 degrees F. Winds ESE at 5 mph.

Ms. Grumieaux and I arrived at the site at 12:37 PM and began the inspection.

Once at the site, Ms. Grumieaux and I parked the vehicle and inspected it from outside the entrance gate. Facing southeast, I viewed a tire on-site. (Photo #1) Facing south, I viewed a large pile containing burned construction debris. (Photo #2) Due to the fence being locked, Ms. Grumieuax and I inspected from the driveway. (Photo #3)

Next, facing southwest, I viewed and documented a second burn pile. I documented that the pile contained more burned construction debris. (Photo #4) While viewing the area, I documented a pile containing household furniture, a mattress, and other miscellaneous items comingled within each other. (Photo #5) Lastly, I viewed a pile that contained a water heater, another mattress, and more burnt construction debris. (Photo #6) After documenting our findings, we concluded the inspection at 12:40 PM.


