RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On October 3, 1980, the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice (45 Fed. Reg. 65956-65973) of the adoption of the following amendments to the New Source Performance Standards:

1. Reference Method 24 of Appendix A, 40 C.F.R. Part 60; and
2. Reference Method 25 of Appendix A, 40 C.F.R. Part 60.


On November 12, 1980, the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice (45 Fed. Reg. 74846-74851) of the adoption of the following amendment to the New Source Performance Standards:

Subpart PP--Standards of Performance for Ammonium Sulfate Manufacture, 40 C.F.R. Part 60.

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Board hereby adopts the above-noted amendments to Part IX of Chapter 2: Air Pollution.
