the process of generating electricity, Marion Station draws water from and discharges back to Lake of

Egypt. In lieu of the alternate thermal effluent limitations: the thermal discharge to Lake of Egypt from SIPC's Marion Generating Station shall not exceed the following maximum temperatures, measured at the outside edge of the 26-acre mixing zone in Lake of Egypt, by more than 1 percent of the hours in a 12-month period: 72°F from December through March, 90°F from April through May, 101°F from June through September, and 91°F from October through November. At no

temperature at the edge of the mixing zone exceed these maximums by more than 3°F. Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be filed with the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. 05/22
