

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

We would like for the Board to consider a review of the above case due to the following.

On June 29, 2011 the site was visited by Phillip Fatka. Robert Dove was the current tenant and was directly responsible for the debris at this site. Robert Dove was notified by the agency of corrective actions needed. At no time did we cause or allow any of the activities alleged to occur. We only became aware that Mr. Dove had been warned after we received a citation and questioned him about it, at which time he produced the warning letter he had received back in 2011. I Jeanetta Maddock as the property owner received no such letter and was unaware of the situation.

It is our understanding that the IEPA sends out letters entitled Open Dump Administrative Citation Warning Notice, before filing an actual citation. At no time were myself or my mother notified by the IEPA of any actions necessary on our part, nor did we receive such a warning notice that there were concerns needing corrective action. We received no letters and had no communication with this department. Due to this we were not given the opportunity to remedy the situation. Had we been notified in 2011 we would not be at this point today.

It should also be noted that I, Gary Maddock do not own nor operate said property. I merely assist my mother in collecting rents or making repairs to her rental properties.

We wish to also advise you that corrective measures have been taken and this site cleaned and cleared of debris. We are aware that cleanups performed after the citation are not a defense, however we also feel that we should have been warned prior to an actual citation, as is the common practice of the IEPA. Since the IEPA failed to follow their own established procedure of a warning TO THE PROPERTY OWNER, before filing a citation we feel that these citations should be disposed of. We are simply asking for

fairness in adjudication, if one person gets a warning then all should get a warning and a chance to remedy the situation.
