ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On November 25, 2003, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) issued a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit with conditions to General Electric Company (GE) for its LaSalle County manufacturing facility. On January 6, 2004, GE timely filed a petition asking the Board to review IEPA's determination to impose specified conditions. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302(e). On January 12, 2017, the hearing officer granted petitioner's unopposed motion to amend the caption to reflect a change in ownership of the facility from GE to SABIC Innovative Plastics US LLC (SABIC).


On April 6, 2020, the parties filed a joint motion (Joint Mot.) reporting that they had "reached substantial agreement as to all contested conditions." Joint Mot. at 1. To allow IEPA to modify the permit, the parties requested that the Board remand the permit to IEPA while maintaining jurisdiction of the appeal. *Id.* at 2. On April 16, 2020, the Board granted the joint motion.

On April 20, 2020, SABIC filed a motion for voluntary dismissal (Mot.). SABIC reports that IEPA issued a revised permit reflecting negotiated revisions. Mot. at 2. SABIC moves that the Board dismiss this matter. *Id.*

The Board grant's SABIC's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
