Here are our responses to your questions. For convenience, I've repeated your questions, each of which is followed by our response in bold, red font:

1. 726.602(j)(4): "referred to in this section" › should this be "subsection j"? **No. Corresponding 40 C.F.R. § 266.502(j)(4) uses "section." Further, subsection (l) of Section 726.602 also has a records-retention requirement.**
2. 811.ILLUSTRATION E: Regarding the change from shall to must: Would "will" be more suitable here? **Yes. We plan to revise the text to read as follows at final adoption: "and will expire on"; "expiration date will be automatically extended"; "unused portion of the credit will be available"; "we will duly honor that draft"; and "we will deposit the amount of the draft".**
3. 811.APPENDIX C: Dichlorodifluoromethane appears to be missing an "o". **We plan to correct the misspelling at final adoption.**
