NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- 1) Heading of the Part: Design, Operation and Maintenance Criteria

- 4) <u>Statutory Authority</u>: Implementing Section 14-19 and authorized by Section 27 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act [415 ILCS 5].
- A Complete Description of the Subjects and Issues Involved: On April 16, 2020, the Board adopted the emergency rule, with an effective date of April 17, 2020. R 20-20, April 16, 2020; 44 Ill. Reg. 7777 (May 1, 2020). The emergency rule proposal attempted to extend the renewal period for cross connection control device inspectors (CCCDI) from May 1, 2020 until June 30, 2020, to August 31, 2020 until October 30, 2020. Because the 150-day duration of an emergency rule will expire before the extended deadline of October 30, 2020, the Board is proposing for first notice a general rule extending the CCCDI renewal period.
