**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**


On August 17, 2020, all parties appeared at a telephonic status conference. Discussions centered on the Demand for a Bill of Particulars filed on August 5, 2020, by the respondent, and the response filed on August 17, 2020, by the complainant. The complainant titled the response “Motion to Dismiss” but has since filed an amended response as a response to the Demand for a Bill of Particulars. Without objection, respondent was given until September 14, 2020, to respond.

Further discussion was entertained on the possibility that this enforcement complaint would not be resolved by the time the projects at issue are completed. Respondent opined that complainant’s issue may be a policy issue. Complainant concurred but noted that fines could be assessed against the respondent under the Board’s rules.

Finally, the respondent stated that it would like settlement discussions to continue.

The parties are directed to participate in a telephonic conference call with the hearing officer on October 5, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. The complainant stated that he will set up the call-in information.
