
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On August 27, 2020, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussions centered on the following: Petitioner’s reply (filed August 26, 2020) to respondent’s response to petitioner’s motion to stay; whether respondent intends to file a sur-reply; respondent’s anticipated motion for an extension of time to file the record; whether a waiver of the statutory decision deadline will be filed; possible hearing dates. Regarding the motion for an extension of time to file the record, a question was posed by the petitioner when does the Board need the record. I stated that the Board will need the record prior to the hearing. I will also note that if the parties intend to file a motion for summary judgement, the record will be needed for that.

The parties stated that they will have internal discussions and with each other on the above matters prior to the next scheduled conference call noted below.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on September 1, 2020, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the petitioner, with the petitioner providing a call-in number. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter.
