The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its

Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution

Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On December 18, 2019, the Illinois EPA received a request from Koppers Inc.
 (log number TC-142139, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation
 regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35
 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204. The application was supplemented with additional
 information in emails from September 2020 through January 2021.
- 2. On September 7, 2017, the Illinois Pollution Control Board approved tax certification PCB 18-7 for Koppers, Inc. for Secondary Containment Additions and Wastewater Treatment Additions. The present request for tax certification of water pollution control facilities is for additions built to the previously certified facility.
- 3. The facility's address is:

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the SW ¼ of Section 4, T38N, R13W of the 3rd PM, in Cook County the above street address and consist of the following:

This facility is used to minimize storm water exposure at the product transfer area where the highest probability of a leak is the highest, and is further described in Exhibit A.

4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2014), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: climinating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

- 5. In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2014), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20 (2014) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
- 6. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
- 7. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be

considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

Secondary containment is provided for the railcars or tanker trucks while loading/unloading at the fixed loading racks. The building is designed primarily as a containment structure for the purpose of minimizing exposure of stormwater at the product transfer area where the highest probability of a leak is present.

The Facility has installed the Tank Containment Area to contain and collect leaked and/or spilled petroleum or petroleum products from the Facility breakout tanks and associated equipment piping and pumps at the Facility. The Tank Containment Area prevents the release of leaked/spilled petroleum which may inadvertently pollute and/or contaminate ground waters, surface waters and lands of the State of Illinois. A Process Flow Diagram is not applicable. Influent/Effluent analysis is not applicable.

3.5 Discharge Prevention Measures

40 CFR 112.7(a)(3)(ii)

[You must address in your plan] Discharge or drainage controls such as secondary containment around containers and other structures, equipment, and procedures for the control of a discharge.

The Stickney Plant has fixed loading/unloading racks as well as loading/unloading transfer areas, both of which are identified on Figure 2 – Facility Section Map and Figure ACH-Q062 – Spill Kits and Transfer Locations.

Rail tanker loading and unloading is conducted by Koppers personnel. For each transfer operation, an inspection form is filled out before and after the transfer. The form is signed and turned in and kept in the foreman's office. The Rail Car Inspection Form is included for reference in Appendix F.

Truck tanker loading and unloading is conducted by the contracted trucking company. All truck operators must sign in and weigh trucks at the security office. After unloading, trucks are weighed again at the security office. Truck operators must sign the same form and confirm that that the best management practices for loading and unloading had been conducted. The Tanker Truck Transfer Form is included for reference in Appendix F.

Secondary containment is being provided for the railcars or tanker trucks while loading/unloading at the fixed loading racks. Secondary containment is provided by sloped drainage which leads to the on-site WWTP. The slope drainage is a quick discharge to adjacent trenches or sewer drains, with capacity exceeding the capacity of the railcars or tanker trucks. In addition, the Facility perimeter has walls and a curb to provide secondary containment. At the tanker truck transfer stations located in the middle of the site along Truckers Lane (located between Facility Sections 17A and 17B), containment curbs are located around the transfer stations pump and hose connections.

The fixed loading/unloading racks consist of a fixed rack with a loading/unloading "arm" to facilitate transfer operations. The primary purpose of such racks is to perform the unloading and filling of rail cars. These loading/unloading transfer areas consist of flexible hoses used for transfers of oil-like substance to and/or from containers such as tanker trucks, drums, and portable totes, when a transfer takes place at either of these locations.

Koppers has implemented best management practices for the loading/unloading operations, which include the following measures.

I apologize for not getting back to you sooner. I was out of the office for a couple weeks and I am still getting caught back up. I brought the updated information you provided to our management and they are still concerned that we do not have sufficient information about what is contained in the new additions.

For example, you said "Secondary Containment additional improvements include installations at the facilities Tank Farm to contain and collect leaked/spilled hazardous liquid." We don't have information about what these installations are or how many you added. Our tax certification applications typically include detailed descriptions of the installations including the amount installed and the dimensions.

Similarly, you wrote, "Wastewater Treatment System Additions include additions to the Facility to contain, collect and treat process waters and regulated storm-water run-off. The additions to the Wastewater treatment systems include the wastewater tanks and heaters." We don't have information about what the additions are that will contain, collect, and treat process waters and regulated storm-water run-off. As I mentioned above, our tax certification applications typically include detailed descriptions of the additions including the amount installed and the dimensions. The same question applies to the additions related to wastewater tanks and water heaters.

If we get more specific descriptions of the additions and improvements including things like dimensions and number of installations, we should be prepared to submit the recommendation for approval.
