



NOTICE OF HEARING

The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearings regarding rule changes proposed by the Illinois Environmental Regulatory Group on August 16, 2021 Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 203: Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification, 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 204: Prevention of Significant Deterioration, and Part 232: Toxic Air Contaminants, R22-17. If adopted by the Board, the Illinois EPA will submit proposed amendments to Part 203 and Part 204 to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) for review and approval as a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision to satisfy Clean Air Act ("CAA") requirements regarding Nonattainment New Source Review and Prevention of Significant Deterioration. 42 U.S.C. §§7410(a)(2)(C), and 7471 and 7502. The revisions submitted to U.S. EPA will include not only the amendments to current regulatory provisions under this proposal, but also the newly created provisions, as well as an analysis demonstrating that the proposal does not interfere with attainment or maintenance of any applicable National Ambient Air Quality Standard, reasonable further progress, or any other applicable requirement of the CAA. This notice is intended to satisfy the requirements of Section 110(l) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. §7410(l), regarding public notice for SIP submittals. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings and to submit written comments. Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, February 17, 2022, beginning at 9:00 AM at the James R.
