On December 20, 2021, Scenic Ridge Plaza, Inc. (Scenic Ridge) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 3495 Goreville Road in Goreville, Johnson County. Scenic Ridge had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) in which the Agency partially denied Scenic Ridge’s request for reimbursement regarding its leaking UST site. The Board grants Scenic Ridge’s motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
