ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On March 29, 2022, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Bank of Pontiac may appeal a March 4, 2022, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns Bank of Pontiac’s underground storage tank (UST) site located at 12 East Jackson Street in Morton, Tazewell County. The Agency partially denied petitioner’s request for reimbursement from the UST Fund.

The Board extends the appeal period until July 13, 2022, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Bank of Pontiac fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
