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MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

NOW COMES the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency or Illinois EPA), by and through one of its attorneys, Sara G. Terranova, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500 and 101.522, requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) grant Illinois EPA additional time to respond to pre-filed follow up questions in the above captioned proceeding. In support of this motion, the Illinois EPA states as follows:

1. On December 7, 2021, the Illinois EPA filed a proposal to amend Part 620 of the Board's groundwater quality regulations. The Board held the first hearing in this matter on March 9, 2022. The hearing focused on testimony from Agency witnesses. On March 11, 2022, the Hearing Officer set the deadline for pre-filed follow-up questions directed to the Agency for March 18, 2022. On March 18, 2022, the Hearing Officer set a deadline for the Agency to file answers to pre-filed questions for April 29, 2022.

2. While working diligently to respond to questions received, the Agency has found that due to the volume of questions and the time needed to fully respond to them, many of which are complex and technical in nature, additional time is necessary for completion.

3. Therefore, to allow the Agency time to thoroughly and completely answer each question, the Agency is requesting an additional week to file its pre-filed answers.

4. The American Chemistry Council, the National Waste and Recycling Association, Dynegy Midwest Generation LLC, et al., and the PFAS Regulatory Coalition have each indicated no objection to the Agency's motion for extension of time file its pre-filed answers.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA requests an additional week to file its pre-filed answers such that it would be due on Friday, May 6, 2022.
