ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie):

On April 21, 2022, the parties timely filed a request to extend the 35-day period within which ExxonMobil Oil Corp. (Exxon) may appeal a March 30, 2022 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA), which was served on Exxon on April 2, 2022. The determination concerns Exxon's proposed corrective action plan (plan) and corrective action budget (budget) with respect to free product from leaking underground storage tanks. The IEPA rejected both the plan and the budget.

The Board extends the appeal period until Monday, August 5, 2022, as Exxon requests and to which the IEPA consents. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Exxon fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
