ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. F. Currie):

On April 7, 2022, at the parties' request, the Board extended until July 13, 2022, the time period for Bank of Pontiac to appeal a March 4, 2022, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns Bank of Pontiac's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 12 East Jackson Street in Morton, Tazewell County. The Agency partially denied petitioner's request for reimbursement from the UST Fund. Because Bank of Pontiac failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
