Hearing Officer Horton -

I am following up to ascertain when you might rule on the Joint Motion for Extension (of Pre-Filing

Deadlines) I filed last week. As stated in the motion, I consulted with all counsel representing participants in this proceeding, including of course IEPA counsel. In fact, we were all under the impression (based upon our prior pre-hearing conference, as reiterated in your email to me below) that the filing deadlines were going to be extended out by two weeks beyond the original deadline. Thus, we were surprised to see the scheduled due date for pre-filed testimony set for August 5.

Despite due diligence, I can honestly say that the August 5 date is undoable for NWRA. I know that other participants, particularly the PFAS coalition (and especially the Ill Association of Wastewater Agency members of PFAS coalition) are equally having a difficult time meeting that deadline. We had a very good conversation with Sara Terranova at IEPA prior to filing our motion; that conversation is reiterated in the motion.
