

It shall be mandatory upon each contractor to pay at minimum the current prevailing hourly rate of wages as set forth in the most current Wage Determination Orders of the Illinois Department of Labor for Jefferson County, IL.

It shall be mandatory upon the successful bidder to provide a Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bond before commencing work. Bonds must come from a surety company with an A+ best rating and licensed in all states.

Bid Security Bond or certified bank draft shall be required of each bidder at the close of bidding in the amount of five (5%) percent of the total bid amount as set forth in the Instruction to Bidders.
