ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On March 15, 2017, the City of Monmouth timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a February 2, 2017 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The Agency’s determination concerns the City of Monmouth’s leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 1125 North Main Street in Monmouth, Warren County. On March 23, 2017, the Board accepted the petition for hearing.

On February 21, 2023, the City of Monmouth filed a motion to dismiss (Mot.). The motion states that the City of Monmouth “no longer seeks to appeal” the determination and requests that the Board dismiss this matter. Mot. at 1. The Board grants the City of Monmouth’s motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
