MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 1974 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##73-223, Marblehead Lime; 74-142, DuPont; 74-209, 74-227, American Cyanamid; 74-248, Perk Foods; 74-254, Indian Springs Farm, (interim order); 74-261, Essaness Theatres, (interim order); 74-268, Western Acadia; 74-275, Sherwin-Williams; R73-14, Procedural Rules Amendments (opinion only).

Carmel; 72-81, Tee-Pak; 74-191, Mackey et al; 74-232, Carthage.

Motion to dismiss was allowed in #72-516, Edwin Cooper by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss was allowed in #74-207, People v. Daniels by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motion to withdraw was allowed in #74-286, Brearley by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motion to withdraw was allowed in #74-290, Galva Foundry by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Henss abstained and Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motions to suspend hearings in R74-7, Toxic Substances by Illinois Fertilizer and Illinois Society of Professional Engineers was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

The Board on its own motion voted to suspend the briefing schedule in 74-146, Marblehead Lime until they vote on a motion for additional hearing. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Marder will prepare an order.

Motions in ##72-466, Rail-to-Water and R72-18, Grain Dryers were discussed and held to October 17 for action.

The Board took note of additional information filed in these cases and ordered them held for Agency recommendations: ##74-230, Miller; 74-236, McMackin; 74-288, Addison; 74-304, Owen Bulls. #74-313, Ecko Lake was orderd held to October 17.

The Board decided to ask the Attorney General to appeal a decision handed down by the Appellate Court in #72-164, Allied Metal.

Mr. Marder said he would request that the I.E.Q. do a study on supplemental control systems and its application in the State of Illinois.

Mr. Henss reported on the progress of the R74-7, Toxic Substances hearings.

Barrington Sportsmen, hearing mandatory, ordered consolidated with #74-303; 74-361, Texaco, dismissed, order by Mr. Marder; 74-362, Municipal Waterworks System, additional information requested; 74-363, (agenda 10/24); 74-364, Central DuPage Hospital Association, held to October 17 for action.

The Board decided to reschedule the meeting of November 21 to November 22, 1974. They also decided to cancel the meeting set for November 28, 1974 and December 26, 1974 due to the pending holidays.
