79-236, Commonwealth Edison was dismissed pursuant to a motion
filed by petitioner by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare
an Order.

R82-18, RCRA, Phase I, Final Order, adopted Rule, was adopted
by a vote of 5-0.

Motions to dismiss were granted in ##79-160,-266 and 81-101, U.S.
Steel, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Orders.
