ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie):

On March 31, 2023, the People of the State of Illinois, *ex rel.* the State's Attorney for Lake County (People), filed a one-count complaint against the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois (IDOT). The complaint concerns noise caused by transverse rumble strips installed in 2019 across the northbound lanes on a portion of United States Highway 41 (US-41) south of Park Avenue W in IDOT's jurisdiction, and the residential area of the west of this portion of US-41, in Highland Park, Lake County.

On March 20, 2025, the People filed a motion for voluntary dismissal of their petition (Mot.). The People report that IDOT does not oppose the request. Mot. at 1.

The Board grants the unopposed motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the petition, and closes the docket.
