ORDER OF THE BOARD (by R. C. Flenal):

Pursuant to Board order dated August 24, 1995 directing the parties to file status reports by September 1, 1995, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a Status Report and Agency Motion to File Status Report Instantly on September 7, 1995.¹

The Agency requests this matter not be set for hearing, but asks that the parties be allowed a reasonable amount of time to review petitioner's Amended Closure Plan.

The Board accepts the Agency's status report and grants the Agency's motion to file instantly. The Board notes that petitioner J & M Plating did not respond to the Board's August 24th order directing the filing of a status report. Nonetheless the Board orders both parties to file a status report by November 1, 1995.
