ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On March 18, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Chroma Corporation (Chroma) may appeal a February 11, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency issued a final decision that certain of Chroma's "stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity are possibly causing or contributing to a violation of water quality standard . . . and may not be appropriately covered by the NPDES General Storm Water Permit for Industrial Activities . . . [making it] necessary that Chroma . . . apply for an NPDES individual permit." Chroma's facility is located in McHenry County. The Board extends the appeal period until June 14, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Chroma fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
