ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon receipt of a June 30, 1988, Agency Recommendation from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). On May 20, 1988 the Agency received a request for provisional variance from LTD Industries, Inc. Specifically, Petitioner requests a 30-day extension of the 90-day deadline for on-site storage of hazardous wastes citing unforeseen, temporary and uncontrollable circumstances as the reasons why the variance is necessary.

In its Agency Recommendation of June 30, 1988, the Agency recommends granting of the requested provisional variance noting that failure to do so would result in an arbitrary and unreasonable hardship.

The Board hereby grants provisional variance to LTD Industries, Inc., pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.134(b) to store hazardous waste on-site from May 24, 1988 to June 22, 1988.
