

- (C) Commonwealth Edison shall report to the Agency each quarter starting September 1, 1978 on its progress towards compliance and shall report monitoring results for Powerton in a manner acceptable to the Agency.
- (D) Edison shall continue the installation of flue gas desulfurization equipment on Boiler #51.
- (E) Within 45 days of the adoption of this Order, the Commonwealth Edison Company shall execute and forward to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 2200 Churchill Road, Springfield, Illinois 62706 a Certification of Acceptance and Agreement to be bound to all terms and conditions of this Order. The 45 day period shall be held in abeyance during any period this matter is being appealed. The form of said certification shall be as follows:

- (3) This variance shall terminate earlier upon any Rule or Order entered under Section 125 of the Federal

Clean Air Act (42 USC 741 et seq.) requiring
Commonwealth Edison to burn Illinois coal at
Powerton.
