ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Henss)

The Illinois Pollution Control Board hereby requests the Institute for Environmental Quality and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to conduct a study of the environmental effects of leaf burning for the purpose of determining whether, to what extent and in which geographical areas leaf burning will produce in the atmosphere contaminants in sufficient quantities and of such characteristics and duration as to be injurious to humans, plant or animal life, or health. The study should be conducted at the earliest time which is feasible in the judgment of the Agency making the study.
