Opinion & Order of the Board (by Mr. Currie):

On July 25, 1972 (5 PCB ), we entered an order upon stipulated facts and the parties' arguments, imposing a \$1,000 penalty for the admitted installation of certain equipment capable of emitting air contaminants without a permit. The Agency then moving to vacate the order on the ground that a public hearing scheduled and never cancelled had not been held, we granted the motion to afford an opportunity for both parties and the public to present any additional material desired for our consideration. 5 PCB (Aug. 22, 1972).

The hearing has since been held; the company indicates that it has paid the penalty assessed and has acquiesced in the original order was correct; no member of the public asked to be heard. Accordingly, as both parties request, we hereby reinstate the Board's order of July 25, 1972.
