Board members agreed last week to construct an addition to the existing 10,000-square-foot building and dropped plans to relocate. Estimated cost for the project of 8,000 to 12,000 square feet is \$1 million, but the amount would be considerably less than building a new library.

Three-term 2nd Ward Republican Alderman JoAnne Schwade is not backing away from her support of the Kankakee Region Landfill project as she seeks her fourth council term.

And, Schwade said, she has only heard from two ward residents opposing the 236-acre landfill project being eyed for a section of land in rural Otto Township.

Given my druthers I would prefer some high-tech industry locating here, but that's not going to happen right now and it's obvious there is a need for this space," she

The Kankakee City Council unanimously approved the siting request by Town & Country Utilities Inc. president Tom Volini last summer. An appeal to the Illinois Pollution Control Board by current Kankakee County landfill operator Waste Management, the Kankakee County Board and resident Byron Sandberg overturned the council

A new set of siting hearings for Volini's project are likely to be held in June.

The regional landfill would accept out-of-county waste and the city would collect about \$2 million a year through the host fee agreement with Volini.



For 2nd Ward aldermanic candidate James Taylor Jr., the proposition of establishing a second landfill within Kankakee County's borders is a difficult subject.

The candidate believes Waste Management can adequately handle the waste needs of this county. However, he knows the host fees proposed by the developer of the Kankakee Regional Landfill would provide slack for the city's tight budget.

"I have nothing bad to say about Tom Volini (Town & Country Utilities Inc. president and landfill developer)," Taylor said. "I just don't know if he could be any better job than Waste Management."

Taylor, however, has made it clear he was not closing his mind to discussions with Volini.

"I would not turn a deaf ear to Mr. Volini. More information needs to be provided so the council can make the best decision possible."

Through the host fee agreement as approved by the Kankakee City Council, the city would receive about \$2 million a year for a little more than 20 years. Also receiving money through the host fee would be the Kanka-
