# REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to June 3, 2004, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On January 29, 2004, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On March 3, 2004, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The Petitioner has subsequently confirmed that the final decision was received no earlier than January 30, 2004.. (Exhibit B)

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the Site Investigation Plan Budget (budget) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This budget, dated November 13, 2003, was received by the Illinois EPA on November 18, 2003. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act), as amended by Public Act 92-0554 on June 24, 2002, and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

The budget is denied for the following reason:

\$5,118.00 deduction in Personnel Costs. Costs for corrective action activities and associated materials or services exceeding the minimum requirements necessary to comply with Title XVI of the Act are ineligible for payment from the Fund (Section 57.5(a) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.000(o)).

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the activities to be completed as part of the plan and made the above overall cut so that the approved amount of personnel costs is reasonable for the tasks involved. It was determined that the total amount approved for personnel costs should be sufficient to accomplish the tasks involved. While the number of hours or type of personnel expected to complete the proposed activities is not specified, a reasonable total amount is specified. How a consultant chooses to use this amount (type of personnel used and number of hours) is discretionary so long as the approved total amount is not exceeded and the personnel hourly wages are reasonable.

### Appeal Rights

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
