REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, James G. Richardson, Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to November 12, 2007, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of receipt of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On July 5, 2007, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner.
- 2. On July 25, 2007, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA to join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition by ninety days. Upon information and belief the Petitioner did receive the final decision on July 10, 2007.

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the Amended Site Investigation Budget (amended budget) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This amended budget, dated June 8, 2007, was received by the Illinois EPA on June 11, 2007. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act), as amended by Public Act 92-0554 on June 24, 2002, and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

The proposed amended budget is modified pursuant to Sections 57.7(a)(2) and 57.7(c) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.505(b) and 734.510(b). The modifications are listed in Section 2 of Attachment A The maximum amounts that can be paid from the Fund must be determined in accordance with Subpart H of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734 (35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.310(b)). Please be advised that costs associated with materials, activities, and services must be reasonable, must be consistent with the associated technical plan, must be incurred in the performance of corrective action activities, must not be used for corrective action activities in excess of those necessary to meet the minimum requirements of the Act and regulations, and must not exceed the maximum payment amounts set forth in Subpart H, Appendix D, and Appendix E of Part 734 (Section 57.7(c) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.510(b)).

NOTE: Pursuant to Section 57.8(a)(5) of the Act, if payment from the Fund will be sought for any additional costs that may be incurred as a result of the Illinois EPA's modifications, an amended budget must be submitted. Amended plans and/or budgets must be submitted and approved prior to the issuance of a No Further Remediation (NFR) Letter. Costs associated with a plan or budget that have not been approved prior to the issuance of an NFR Letter will not be paid from the Fund.

Pursuant to Sections 57.7(a)(5) and 57.12(c) and (d) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.100 and 734.125, the Illinois EPA requires submittal of a Site Investigation Completion Report within 30 days after completing the site investigation to:

\$2,850.00 was previously approved by the Illinois EPA on September 27, 2005 for Project Manager Site Investigation Work Plan and Budget writing and data review. \$3,200.00 was

previously approved by the Illinois EPA on August 10, 2006 for Senior Project Manager for Amended Site Investigation Plan and Budget writing.

2. \$493.36 for Senior Draftsman/CAD, which exceed the minimum requirements necessary to comply with the Act. Costs associated with site investigation and corrective action activities and associated materials or services exceeding the minimum requirements necessary to comply with the Act are not eligible for payment from the Fund pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(3) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.630(o).

\$605.00 was previously approved by the Illinois EPA on September 27, 2005 for Draftsman for mapping and figures and updates. \$480.00 was previously approved by the Illinois EPA on August 10, 2006 for Senior Draftsman/CAD for CAD maps for development of SIWP map and figures.

3. \$678.36 for Senior Accounting Technician, which exceed the minimum requirements necessary to comply with the Act. Costs associated with site investigation and corrective action activities and associated materials or services exceeding the minimum requirements necessary to comply with the Act are not eligible for payment from the Fund pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(3) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.630(o).

\$650.00 was previously approved by the Illinois EPA on September 27, 2005 for Project Coordinator for reimbursement package prep and purchase agreement. \$550.00 was previously approved by the Illinois EPA on August 10, 2006 for Senior Account Tech for reimbursement package preparation, owner certification and budget tracking.
