The Respondent, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by and through its attorneys in accordance with the Illinois Pollution Control Board's Order of July 26, 2007, and pursuant to the procedural requirements of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") set forth at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.212 and 105.116, files its Administrative Record ("Administrative Record") in this cause.

Acting in accordance with its authority under the provisions of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter "Act"), 415 ILCS 5/39(a) (2006), the Illinois EPA issued a construction permit to Midwest Generation, LLC ("Midwest Generation") on June 15, 2007. The permit authorized the construction of a soda ash (sodium carbonate) handling system and soda ash application system to apply soda ash to the coal as it is delivered from the rail car dumper at the Will County Station located at 529 East 135th Street in Romeoville, Illinois.

On or about July 20, 2007, Petitioner filed a petition before the Board challenging certain permit conditions contained within the construction permit issued by the Illinois

EPA. The Illinois EPA received an electronic version of the appeal on July 23, 2007. Formal notice of the appeal was served on the Illinois EPA on the same date.

The Illinois EPA herewith files five copies (i.e., a signed original and four (4) duplicative copies) of the Administrative Record in accordance with 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.302(h). One copy is being served on the Petitioner and one copy with the assigned Hearing Officer.

This Administrative Record is comprised of non-privileged documents and communications, as made known and available to the undersigned attorney through other Illinois EPA personnel, that was relied upon by the Illinois EPA's Division of Air Pollution Control/ Permits Section in the issuance of the subject construction permit.
