
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On May 1, 2008, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which City of Quincy (City) may appeal a March 27, 2008 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206. The Agency's determination concerns the City's Quincy Wastewater Treatment Facility located at 700 West Lock & Dam Road in Quincy, Adams County. In the determination, the Agency issued a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to the City with conditions.

The Board extends the appeal period until July 30, 2008, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206. If the City fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
