Dear Clerk,

As a Peoria County resident, I am deeply concerned about what is allowed in our landfill, and the potential for impact on water, land and air as a result.

After attending the public hearing for Peoria Disposal Company's appeal to delist electric arc furnace dust, my request is that it not be de-listed. It's hard to be assured when a company hires their own research scientist to do a fairly short term study on making a pollutant/contaminant safe - particularly when PDC has been pushing for a long time - very persistently thru many Peoria County and EPA denials - to allow hazardous

waste at the Peoria County
Landfill - an expansion of what is
already accepted.

Once it becomes possible to "de-list" hazardous waste, what would stop many other requests to de-list by other companies, it seems opening Pandora's Box.

We have to think long term - how do we know EAF treated now will be forever stabilized.

Thank you for all that you do to control pollution in Illinois.
