RECOMMENDATION

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“Illinois EPA”) hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On December 28, 2007, the Illinois EPA received a request from Gary Donley, Timberline, LLC (log number TC-46-07, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
2. The applicant’s address is:

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located at Section 12, T3N, R2W of the 4th P.M. in Schuyler County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste management facilities consisting of one concrete pit (80 ft. x 168 ft. x 10 ft. deep) with six concrete pump out pits (each 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 10 ft. deep) and the portion of the plastic slotted flooring over the manure pit in Building # 1; one concrete pit (76 ft. x 636 ft. x 10 ft. deep) with sixteen concrete pump out pits (each 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 10 ft. deep) and the portion of the concrete slotted flooring over the manure pits in Building # 2; one concrete pit (76 ft. x 636 ft. x 10 ft. deep) with sixteen concrete pump out pits (each 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 10 ft. deep) and the portion of the concrete slotted flooring over the manure pits in Building # 3; one concrete pit (76 ft. x 737 ft. x 2 ft. deep) and the portion of the plastic and cast iron slotted flooring over the manure pit in Building # 4; and approximately 50 ft. of 8 inch diameter PVC manure transfer piping. These

livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock wastes prior to cropland application.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport and/or store livestock wastes prior to cropland application., and are further described in Exhibit A.

4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2006), defines

“pollution control facilities” as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: (a) eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or (b) treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

5. Pollution control facilities are entitled to preferential tax treatment, 35 ILCS 200/11-5.
6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facilities, it is the Illinois EPA’s engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered “pollution control facilities,” pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the

requested tax certification.

The Bureau of Water received a request on December 28, 2007 from Timberline, LLC for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Il. Adm. Code 125.204. We offer the following recommendation.

The water pollution control facilities in this request include the following:

Livestock waste management facilities consisting of one concrete pit (80 ft. x 168 ft. x 10 ft. deep) with six concrete pump out pits (each 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 10 ft. deep) and the portion of the plastic slotted flooring over the manure pit in Building # 1; one concrete pit (76 ft. x 636 ft. x 10 ft. deep) with sixteen concrete pump out pits (each 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 10 ft. deep) and the portion of the concrete slotted flooring over the manure pits in Building # 2; one concrete pit (76 ft. x 636 ft. x 10 ft. deep) with sixteen concrete pump out pits (each 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 10 ft. deep) and the portion of the concrete slotted flooring over the manure pits in Building # 3; one concrete pit (76 ft. x 737 ft. x 2 ft. deep) and the portion of the plastic and cast iron slotted flooring over the manure pit in Building # 4; and approximately 50 ft. of 8 inch diameter PVC manure transfer piping. These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock wastes prior to cropland application.

These facilities are further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.

Based on the information included in this submittal, it is our engineering judgment that the above proposed facilities may be considered "Pollution Control Facilities" under 35 IAC 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in this section, and therefore eligible for tax certification from the Illinois Pollution Control Board. The Bureau of Water therefore recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification for these facilities.
