JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008).

FACTS

- That Steve Danielson is the current owner ("Respondent") of a facility located at 13912 1675 East Street, Princeton, Bureau County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Wyanet Township/Danielson.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0118240001.
 - That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on April 6, 2010, Donna Shehane of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Rockford Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on May 4, 2010 Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7008 1830 0001 4720 7905

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Donna Shehane during the course of her April 6, 2010 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2008).

CIVIL PENALTY

On January 22, 2009, the Board found Steve Danielson in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act in AC 09-27.

Because this Administrative Citation addresses a second or subsequent violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each violation, for a total of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than June 30, 2010, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing,

Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2008). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

On April 6, 2010 I (Donna Shehane) conducted an inspection at 13912 1675 East Street in Princeton, Illinois to monitor the cleanup of the property. The weather at the time of this inspection was 75 °F with WSW winds at 21 mph.

The property owner (Mr. Danielson) had received the initial Administrative Citation Warning Notice for an April 14, 2008 inspection. After several deadline extensions, an Administrative Citation in the amount of \$1500.00 was issued for an October 16, 2008 inspection. Mr. Danielson paid this fine.

A new cleanup deadline was given of April 17, 2009. Substantial progress was observed during the May 18, 2009 inspection so a clean up deadline extension was again granted to July 6, 2009. On July 6, 2009 I reinspected the site and found additional progress had been made so an extension was granted to September 18, 2009. On September 30, 2009 an inspection was conducted which verified additional cleanup progress. An extension to December 1, 2009 was granted. A December 18, 2009 inspection was conducted and a final extension deadline of February 28, 2010 was granted.

I arrived on site at approximately 12:15 pm and met with Mr. Danielson. The inspection began on the east side of 1675 East Road. Photo # 1, taken to the east, shows remaining bags of waste to be disposed of. Photo # 2 reveals the dumpster still on site with bags of waste inside and on the ground surrounding the dumpster. Photo # 3 depicts metal debris strewn on the ground. Photo # 4 was taken of more bags of waste on the ground. Photo # 5 reveals partially opened bags of waste, including food containers, beverage containers, papers, and plastics.

Photos # 6 and # 7 were taken of remaining bags of waste and litter located inside a barn. Photo # 8 was taken to the southeast of bags of household waste strewn on the property, including food items and containers.

I left the site at approximately 12:30 pm. The Steve Danielson property was found to remain in apparent violation of the following during this inspection after approximately two years since my first inspection:

- 1. Section 21(a) of the Act: Cause Or Allow Open Dumping.
- 2. Section 21(d)(1) of the Act: Conduct Any Waste-Storage, Waste-Treatment, Or Waste-Disposal Operation: Without A Permit
- Section 21(d)(2) of the Act: Conduct Any Waste-Storage, Waste-Treatment, Or Waste-Disposal Operation: In Violation of Any Regulations or Standards Adopted by the Board.

- 4. Section 21(e) of the Act: Dispose, Treat, Store, Or Abandon Any Waste, Or Transport Any Waste Into the State At/To Sites Not Meeting Requirements of the Act.
- Sections 21(p)(1) of the Act: Cause Or Allow The Open Dumping of Any Waste In A Manner Which Results In Any Of The Following Occurrences At The Dump Site: (1) Litter
- Section 812.101(a) of the 35 Illinois Administrative Code Requirements Subtitle G: Failure To Submit An Application For A Permit To Develop And Operate A Landfill.


