HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On December 10, 2010, a hearing officer order scheduled a hearing in this proceeding on Thursday, February 3, 2011, in Chicago. However, blizzard conditions on Wednesday, February 2, 2011, severely impeded travel and caused State offices, including the Board's, to close on that date. Although the hearing officer convened the hearing as scheduled on February 3, 2011, it was continued on the record to Thursday, February 17, 2011. The hearing resumed as scheduled on February 17, 2011, and concluded that day.

Under the Board's procedural rules, "[a]ny person may submit written comments on any proposal within 14 days after the receipt of the hearing transcript in Board offices unless otherwise specified by the hearing officer or the Board." 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.108(b). The Board expects to receive the complete transcript of this hearing on or before Friday, February 25, 2011.

Any person who wishes to file a post-hearing comment with the Board is directed to do so on or before Friday, March 4, 2011. The "mailbox rule" at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2) does not apply to the filing of any post-hearing comments, and the Board's Clerk must receive these comments at or before the close of business on Friday, March 4, 2011.

Comments and other documents may be filed electronically through the Clerk's Office On-Line (COOL) from the Board's Web site at www.ipcb.state.il.us. Comments must be properly served to participants on the Service List for this proceeding. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.108(c).
