# ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On January 13, 2010, the County of Vermilion filed an administrative citation against Charles Long. *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108. The administrative citation concerns a property located at the area of 133 West Williams Street, Danville, Vermilion County. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as the "Long" site and is designated with Site Code No. 183020073. The County of Vermilion alleged that on November 10, 2009, Charles Long violated Section 21(p) (1), (3) and (7) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (3) and (7) (2008)) by open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, open burning, and deposition of construction or demolition debris, at respondent's Vermilion County site.

On May 16, 2011, the County of Vermilion filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the administrative citation. In the motion, the County of Vermilion states that "as all matter have been resolved and no further administrative proceeding is required." The Board therefore grants the County of Vermilion's motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.

The Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the statutory authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by section 4(e) and 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("act") 415 ILCS 5/4(e), 5/31.1, and delegated to Vermilion County Pursuant to section 4(r) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/4(r).

### FACTS

- 1. That Respondent, Charles Long, is, and was at all times relevant to this Administrative Citation, the owner of property located at the area of 133 West Williams Street, Danville, more particularly Latitude 40.1340, Longitude -87.6515.
- That said property is operated as a mobile home park and vacant land which is not permitted as a sanitary landfill or dump area.
- 3. That on 11-10-2009 Douglas Toole of the Vermilion County Realth Department inspected the above-described property. Douglas Toole's Affidavit and a copy of his inspection report are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

# VIOLATIONS

- 1. On the basis of direct observations personally made by Douglas Toole, the County of Vermilion has determined that on 11-10-2009:
  - A. The Respondent was allowing the open dumping of waste which resulted in litter in violation of Section 21(p)(1).
  - B. The Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste which resulted in open burning in violation of Section 21(p)(3).

C. The Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of any waste which results in the deposition of general construction or demolition debris and clean construction and demolition debris in violation of Section 21(p)(7).

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CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 for each violation of each provision under subsection p of Section 21, plus any hearing costs incurred by the Board should the Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described hereinbelow.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Administrative Citation under Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d). If you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, you must file a petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control, at the State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. Such Petition for Review must be filed with thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation, or a default judgment will be issued by the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review should be filed with the Vermilion County State's Attorney's Office, Courthouse, 2nd Floor, 7 N Vermilion Street, Danville, Illinois, 61832. If you acknowledge the violation herein, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than 2-8-2010. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of the Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the service hereof and have not paid the civil penalty by the due date stated above, or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you. When payment is made, your check should be made payable to the County of Vermilion, Illinois and mailed to the Vermilion County Health Department, 200 South College

Street, Danville, Illinois, 61832, together with a completed copy of the remittance

If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after hearing, is not paid when due, the Vermilion County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in the Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty and any hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover its costs of litigation
