Notice of Amended Petition by Greif Inc. and Greif Packaging LLC for an Adjusted Standard before the Illinois Pollution Control Board On May 31, 2011, Greif, Inc. and Greif Packaging LLC (Greif) filed an Amended Petition for an Adjusted Standard (Petition) with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board), Docket Number 2011-001 seeking an adjusted standard from 35 III. Adm. Code § 218,988(a) as it applies to control requirements for emissions of volatile organic material (VOM) at Greif's facility located at 3 South 220 Frontenac Road, Naperville, Illinois 69683. Greif's Naperville Badilly manufactures filber (paper) diums. Greif conducts quality control (QC) testing of polyethylene liners included in some drums by spraying a QC test fluid (a denatured alcohol product, which is a VOM) into the drum interior. The drums are conveyed to an inspection station for visual inspection and then conveyed to a inspection station for visual inspection and then conveyed to a hind location for evaporation and removal of the QC test fluid (a Control of the Control of

2. Greif will reduce VOM emissions from its OC Test Process by using a test fluid composed of 45 percent denalured alcohol and

2. Greif will reduce YOM emissions from its QC Test Process by using a test fluid composed of 45 percent denatured alcohol and 55 percent water.

3. The QC Test Process equipment will be calibrated to spray no more than an average of 48 grams of QC test fluid per drum to be measured as follows: once per quarter Greif will conduct a test to verify that the average amount of QC test fluid sprayed into at least five drums meets this condition.

4. All records and logs required by this adjusted standard shall be retained at a readily accessible location at the source for at least five years from the date of entry and shall be made avoidable for inspection and copying by the filinots Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) upon request. Any records retained in an electronic format (e.g., computer) shall be capable of being retrieved and printed on paper during normal source office hours on a beautiful and the course of a source inspection.

5. Greif will maintain records of its denatured alcohol usage that will allow the monthly cabulation of the amount of denatured alcohol used during the month and the calculation of VOM emissions on a 12-month rolling lotal basis for comparison to annual VOM limits in Greif's Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP).

5. Greif will continue to investigate the availability of alternative OC test fluids with lower VOM content. Greif will incorporate such lower VOM CC test fluids allow vicual detection of pinholes or other tears or impolections in the drum limings within an acceptable period of time and does not result in any negative product quality impacts.
