A RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO TIERED APPROACH TO CORRECTIVE ACTION OBJECTIVES TO ADD AN INDOOR INHALATION EXPOSURE ROUTE REGULATION (VAPOR INTRUSION)

WHEREAS, certain properties in the City of Champaign, Illinois have been used over a period of time for commercial and industrial purposes; and

WHEREAS, because of said use, concentrations of certain chemical constituents may exceed remediation objectives as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 742; and

WHEREAS, volatile chemicals may have the potential to migrate from the groundwater or soil to indoor air; and

WHEREAS, it is prudent and desirable for the indoor inhalation exposure route to be evaluated prior to a contaminated site's use of the City's groundwater restriction ordinance as an institutional control in accordance with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Tiered Approach to Corrective Action Objectives for site remediation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council supports the proposal of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to amend the Tiered Approach to Corrective Action Objectives (35 Ill. Adm. Code 742) to add an indoor inhalation exposure route provision to the regulations. The proposed amendment is currently under consideration before the Illinois Pollution Control Board. The Docket Sheet is attached to this Resolution.

Section 2. That a copy of the Resolution be filed at the Illinois Pollution Control Board, reference Case No: R2011-009.
