ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On January 20, 2012, Knapp Oil Company (Knapp) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund for Knapp's leaking UST site located at 100 North Broadway in Central City, Marion County. Knapp had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) partially rejecting Knapp's UST Fund reimbursement request. Knapp's motion represents that the parties have resolved their disagreements and that Knapp no longer seeks Board review of the Agency's determination. The Board grants Knapp's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
