ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.A. Holbrook):

On April 25, 2012, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the Broadus Oil Company (Broadus) may appeal a March 20, 2012 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency rejected a Corrective Action Plan Budget dated November 17, 2011, for the “Streator/Pit Stop West facility located at 1006 West Main Street, Streator, LaSalle County.

The Board extends the appeal period until July 24, 2012, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Broadus fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
