ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against City of Carlinville, an Illinois municipal corporation, for violation of State pollution control rules. On March 6, 2013, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement.
