MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE RECORD

NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (“Illinois EPA”), by and through its attorneys, in accordance with the procedural rules of the Illinois Pollution Control Board as set forth in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116, and hereby moves the ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD (“Board”) for an extension of time to file the Record in the above matter.

Section 105.116 provides that “If the State agency wishes to seek additional time to file the record, it must file a request for extension before the date on which the record is due to be filed.” 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116. In addition, Section 101.522 provides that “The Board or hearing officer, for good cause shown on a motion after notice to the opposite party, may extend the time for filing any document or doing any act which is required by these rules to be done within a limited period, either before or after the expiration of time.

The Petitioners filed their Petition for Review on April 8, 2013. The record is due on May 8, 2013. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.116.

The record of the Clean Air Act Permit Program (“CAAPP”) permit issued to U.S. Steel by the Illinois EPA on March 4, 2013 is well over 9,000 pages. Due to the size of the record, the

Agency will need additional time to complete compilation and indexing of the record. Based on the foregoing, the Illinois EPA formally requests an extension of time to file its Record with the Board of fourteen (14) days to May 22, 2013.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests that the Board grant this Motion for Extension of Time to File to Record to May 22, 2013.
