ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On June 28, 2013, Congress Development Company (petitioner) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns petitioner's municipal solid waste landfill located at 4100 West Frontage Road in Hillside, Cook County. Petitioner had filed a petition seeking Board review of a March 12, 2013 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). In the determination, the Agency denied petitioner's request to have alternate operating parameters and procedures for certain active landfill gas extraction collectors.

In its motion for voluntary dismissal, petitioner states that on June 25, 2013, the Agency granted petitioner's request for alternate operating parameters and positive pressure limits, rendering this appeal moot. The Board grants petitioner's motion, dismisses this appeal, and closes the docket.
