### JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

#### **FACTS**

- That Bernard Coil and Angie Ratliff are the current owners and operators ("collectively 1. Respondents") of a facility located at 414 Hatfield Road north of Meredosia, Morgan County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Meredosia/Coil.
  - 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1378615005.
  - 3. That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on August 29, 2013, Mark Weber of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Springfield Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- That on 10-15-13, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7012 0476 0001 2973 8579

#### <u>VIOLATIONS</u>

Based upon direct observations made by Mark Weber during the course of the August 29, 2013 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

#### **CIVIL PENALTY**

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>November 15, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each

violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

## PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

On August 29, 2013 Mr. Mark Weber, Division of Land Pollution Control/Field Operations Section (DLPC/DOS) - Springfield Regional Office (SRO), conducted a third complaint inspection of the Coil site located at 414 Hatfield Road north of Meredosia, Illinois. A complainant alleged that "junk and garbage" had been open dumped around the mobile home located on the Coil property. The complainant also alleged that a hose leading from the mobile home was discharging raw sewage onto the ground. The Coil site had been the subject of two previous complaint inspections. The initial site inspection was conducted on August 3, 2006 after a complaint was received by the SRO alleging the open burning and open dumping of wastes at the Coil property. A second complaint was received by the SRO in 2007 alleging that the responsible party had continued to open dump and open burn on-site which prompted an August 29, 2007 reinspection.

As a result of the August 3, 2006 site inspection an Administrative Citation Warning Notification (ACWN) dated September 11, 2006 was sent to Mr. Bernard Coil. Violations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act cited in the inspection report included Sections: 9(c), 21(a), 21(e), 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), 55(a)(1), and 55(a)(2).

The Coil site is located at 414 Hatfield Road in Morgan County due north of Meredosia, Illinois and approximately one mile north of Route 104. The property is described as lot fifty-one (51) in Calvin and Pearl Dunmire Shady Acres Subdivision, situated in township (16) sixteen north and range thirteen (13) west of the third principal meridian. The legal description was derived from a warranty deed filed with the Morgan County Recorder's Office on March 18, 2004. The deed identifies Bernard F. Coil, Jr. and Angie Ratliff as the property owners. A mailing address for Mr. Coil and Ms. Ratliff was provided from property tax records as 11E Frank Wessel Drive in Beardstown, Illinois 62618. Please refer to the attached aerial photograph for a depiction of the site location.

### August 29, 2013 Inspection

The IEPA inspector arrived at the Coil site at approximately 0930 hours on August 29, 2013. The temperature was approximately 80° Fahrenheit. Skies were partly cloudy and

there was no wind. Site soil conditions were dry. The site is located in a residential area in rural Morgan County just east of the Illinois River and just north of Meredosia, Illinois. The Coil property is bordered by residential properties to the north, south, and east. A portion of the Meredosia National Wildlife Refuge is located west of the site.

There is a mobile home located on the Coil property. The IEPA inspector knocked on the door which was answered by a minor child that was home sick from school. When the IEPA inspector asked if Mr. Coil was home the minor stated that he was at one of the neighbors, but that he might return soon. At that point the IEPA inspector decided to conduct the inspection without Mr. Coil present.

The IEPA inspector observed and documented a significant volume of open dumped wastes at the Coil site. The wastes have primarily been open dumped near the entrance to the property and upon what could be best be described as the driveway/yard located immediately south of the mobile home. Open dumped wastes observed and documented during the August 29, 2013 inspection include white goods, landscape debris, plastics, mixed metals, paper, glass, dimensional lumber, doors and windows, and compressed gas cylinders. The IEPA inspector did not find any visual evidence that wastes had been open burned on-site. The inspector also documented the presence of approximately 20 used tires at various locations on-site. The used tires were both on and off the rim. Some of the off rim tires had been allowed to accumulate water. The total volume of open dumped waste on-site has been estimated at 50 cubic yards.

The 2013 complaint also alleged that raw sewage was being pumped onto the ground at the Coil property rather than into a septic or sewage system. The IEPA inspector noted and documented some standing water under the mobile home. However, the soil in this area did not appear stained nor did the inspector detect any odor. There were pieces of cut poly vinyl chloride (PVC) pipe and a bottle of PVC glue near the area of standing water. It appears that some plumbing repair had been made in this area. There was also a piece of flexible hosing leading from the trailer and the area where the plumbing repair had been made. The flexible hosing was not connected to any plumbing underneath the trailer at the time of the inspection. The soil at the other end of the tubing was stained. There was no sewage odor detected at this location either. It is possible that the residents at one point had discharged gray water from their home before the plumbing repair was made. Please refer to the attached photographs for a depiction of site conditions as they existed during the August 29, 2013 inspection.

Photograph #1 depicts wood fence panels, mixed metals, landscape debris, and used tires all open dumped near the entrance to the Coil property.

Photograph #2 provides an overall view of the Coil property from the entrance.

Photograph #3 shows a vinyl tarp, mixed metals, plastics, and dimensional lumber all open dumped on-site. A compressed gas cylinder is also visible.

Photograph #4 was taken of a large sheet of tin, other mixed metals, dimensional lumber, entry doors, windows/glass, and plastics open dumped on-site.

Photograph #5 provides a view of standing water underneath the Coil's mobile home.

Photograph #6 gives a view of the end of a flexible hose that had recently been disconnected from the plumbing under the Coil's mobile home. Some gray staining of the soil is visible.

Photograph #7 shows off rim used tires open dumped near the entrance to the Coil property.

Photograph #8 provides a view of off rim used tires that have been allowed to accumulate water.


Photograph #9 is of mixed metals, plastics, white goods, and dimensional lumber open dumped on-site.

Photograph #10 shows a water heater and furnace open dumped on the Coil property.

The August 29, 2013 inspection of the Coil site was conducted in order to determine if violations cited in the ACWN were still occurring as alleged in the third complaint. The IEPA inspector observed and documented that violations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act cited in the ACWN persist. Violations of the Act that were observed during the re-inspection include Sections: 21(a), 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e), 21(p)(1), 55(a)(1), and 55(k)(1). An apparent violation of the Regulations, 35 Illinois Administrative Code (IAC) Section 812.101(a) persists as well. Refer to the attached Open Dump Checklist for additional information.

The IEPA inspector left the Coil site at approximately 0950 hours to conduct other inspections in Morgan County.




