

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012).

FACTS

- That the County of Whiteside is the permitted owner and Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. is the permitted operator, ("Respondents") of a facility located at 18762 Lincoln Road, Morrison, Whiteside County, Illinois.
- 2. That said facility is a sanitary landfill, operating under Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit No. 1994-579-LF. The facility is designated with Site Code No. 1950350014 and commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Morison/Prairie Hill RDF.
 - That Respondents have owned/operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on December 18, 2013, Kaare Jacobsen of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Rockford Regional Office inspected the above-referenced facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 1-27-14, the Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via

Certified Mail No. 7012 0470 0001 2973 9712 - Whitesia Co.

7012 0470 900/1008 2973 9729 - Waste Mgt.

Based upon direct observations made by Kaare Jacobsen during the course of his December 18, 2013 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill in a manner which resulted in uncovered refuse remaining from the previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, a violation of Section 21(o)(5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21 (o)(5) (2012).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuit to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2012), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation, for a total of <u>Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>February 25, 2014</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2012), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2012). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

- I, Kaare Jacobsen, being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and state as follows:
- 1. Affiant is a field inspector employed by the Land Pollution Control Division of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and has been so employed at all times pertinent hereto.
- 2. On December 18, 2013, between 1100 and 1216, Affiant conducted an inspection of the landfill in Whiteside County, Illinois, known as Prairie Hill RDF, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Site No. 1950350014, operating under IEPA Permit #1994-579-LF.
- 3. Affiant inspected said Prairie Hill RDF site by an on-site inspection, which included walking the site and interviewing personnel.
- 4. Before and/or after said inspection of said landfill site, Affiant reviewed Illinois Environmental Protection Agency permits issued to the subject site and investigated into whether or not required documents were timely filed on behalf of the subject site.
- 5. As a result of the activities referred to in Paragraphs 3 and 4 above, Affiant completed the Inspection Report form attached hereto and made a part hereof, which, to the best of Affiant's knowledge and belief, is an accurate representation of Affiant's observations and factual conclusions with respect to Prairie Hill RDF.

NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT

On December 18, 2013, I (Kaare Jacobsen) conducted a solid waste inspection at the Prairie Hill Recycling & Disposal Facility in Morrison, Illinois. This inspection was conducted to determine whether the facility was in compliance with all applicable rules and regulations according to the solid waste statutes set forth by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The above referenced facility is located on 18762 Lincoln Road. Agency correspondence should be addressed to the facility's manager, Mike Wiersema, at the aforementioned address. Also, additional correspondence should be addressed to the County Engineer of Whiteside County, Russ Renner, at 200 East Knox Street, Morrison, Illinois.

Prior to the inspection, the facility had been issued two permit modifications (Numbers 75 and 76) since the previous inspection that occurred on September 24, 2013. The change in the modification indicated:

- Approval of the Construction Quality Assurance (CQA) Construction Acceptance Assurance Report for the 2013 expansion of the leachate forcemain system.
- Approval of the Construction Quality Assurance (CQA) Construction Acceptance Report for, and grants permission to operate in, Phase 7, Cell-1 west.

Upon arrival at 1100, I introduced myself to the attendants in the scale house, Mike Olson and Teresa Gertson. After brief introduction, Corey Suloff, landfill operator, accompanied me with a tour of the permitted facility. Then, Mr. Suloff and I headed towards the active face of the landfill in Phase 5, Cell 2. At the active face, two 30 yard roll off containers and a semi load was being discarded and heavy machinery consisting of one compactor was observed spreading out the refuse.

After viewing the active face, we headed northwest towards Phase 7, Cell 1 west, where they were operating from the week of December 9th. On the way to the Phase 7, Cell 1 west, two piles of building debris where observed in Phase 5, Cell 3. The facility is permitted to utilize the material as an alternate daily cover material and is allowed to stockpile the material for a six month period. Upon arrival to the Phase 7, Cell 1, we approach the previous active face from the south. From our position (GPS Point N 41.806844, W089.883053) two areas of geotextile fabric where viewed to be blown over and exposing solid waste. Windblown snow covered majority of the exposed areas, suggesting that those two areas have been exposed for some period of time.

After viewing Phase 7, Cell 1, headed towards the scale house to conduct a review of records. On the way to the scale house, there were three temporary employees picking up windblown along the eastern section of Phase 5, Cell 1. Also, on the way to the scale house, it appeared that there was not any landscape waste in the permitted landscape waste drop off area. As we entered the scale house, Mr. Olson and Mrs. Gertson was requested to provide the following records: Random load inspections, leachate recirculation, monthly landfill inspection forms, alternative daily cover log sheets and non-hazardous waste profile sheets. The aforementioned records were requested to be e-mailed to me for review, in a timely manner.

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The inspection concluded at 1216, with the solid waste violations cited: 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e) and 21(o)(5) of the Environmental Protection Act; 811.106(a) and 811.106(b) of 35 Illinois Administrative Code; Permit Condition II, Page 7, # 4; Permit Condition II, Page 8, # 5(b); Permit Condition II, Page 8, # 5(c); Permit Condition II, Page 8, # 5(f); Permit Condition II, Page 8, # 5(g).




