NOW COMES Petitioner, UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION

("Petitioner"), by and through its attorneys, HODGE DWYER & DRIVER, pursuant to

35 Ill. Admin. Code § 101.500, and moves the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board")

to dismiss this action. In support of this Motion, Petitioner states as follows:

- 1. On October 7, 2009, Petitioner filed a Petition for Review ("Petition") of the Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit ("Initial CAAPP Permit") issued to Petitioner by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") on September 3, 2009.
- 2. On October 15, 2009, the Board accepted Petitioner's Petition for hearing. Board Order, *United States Steel Corporation v. Illinois EPA*, PCB No. 10-23 (Ill.Pol.Control.Bd. Oct. 15, 2009).
- 3. On February 21, 2013, the Board issued an order granting Petitioner's motion for a stay of the appeal of the Initial CAAPP Permit. The Board granted the stay through February 4, 2014 and, on February 21, 2014, pursuant to a Hearing Officer Order, the status conference were resumed in this matter. Hearing Officer Order, *United*

States Steel Corporation v. Illinois EPA, PCB No. 10-23 (Ill.Pol.Control.Bd. Feb. 6, 2014).

- 4. Petitioner and Respondent resolved the issues related to this appeal, and Respondent issued a revised CAAPP Permit ("2013 CAAPP Permit") on March 4, 2013.
- 5. The 2013 CAAPP permit is in effect, with exception of the contested conditions stayed by the Board, and Petitioner is complying with the terms and conditions of the 2013 CAAPP permit.
- 6. Petitioner is not aware that any other appeals or petitions to object related to the 2013 CAAPP Permit have been filed, and Petitioner believes any deadlines for such actions have passed. Thus, Petitioner requests that the Board dismiss this matter.
 - 7. Counsel for Respondent does not object to this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, respectfully requests that the Board enter an Order dismissing this action.
